Virtual Rally The New Norm

For the past two months I have been working on what will be another change in our RV life style. Virtual Rallies are coming and I have been fortunate to work with a national RV repair center and designer of most of the RV suspension and Steering enhancements. SuperSteer and Henderson's Line-Up is designing a Virtual Rally platform which will be part of the new normal. There are a few other RV organizations starting to change the way we do things. This will not replace the traditional physical rallies which we all enjoy. With some rallies hundreds of miles or more away, the ability to attend can be difficult and costly for the registration, fuel and other expenses. Most nationwide rallies average 3-4 days, so to make the trip worthwhile you need to add additional visits to the trip, and you can't set the date. With the Virtual Rally launching soon

the Villages Rovers Chapter has been invited to participate in the soft opening along with a Grand Design RV Club on the west coast. The amount of members may be limited due to it being the first launching attempt. The date will be announced by e-mail and the sign up will be on a first come basis. Prior to the virtual rally there will be an informational video on how to connect, it will not be difficult. There will be national vendors giving virtual seminars, and just like any RV seminar there will be a live question and answer time.

After working on this project it seems that virtual rallies will be popping up a lot, and some rallies that you would like to have gone to in the past but was expensive and far away will really be affordable.

Easy, Quick & Good Grilled Lemon Chicken

Ingredients

- 1/2 c lemon juice
- 1/4 c and 2 tbsp olive oil
- 11/2 Tbsp Dijon mustard
- 3 large cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 3 Tbsp red bell pepper, finely chopped
- 3/4 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 6 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves

Preparation

Use a gallon a zip lock bag, mix the lemon juice, olive oil, Dijon mustard, garlic, red bell pepper, salt, and pepper. Set aside 1/4 cup of the mixture to use for basting. Place chicken in the bag, and marinate at least 40 minutes or longer in the refrigerator or cooler. When the coals or grill is hot and ready, drain and discard marinade from the bag. Lightly coat the grill grate with cooking oil or non-stick vegetable spray. Place chicken on the grill. Cook about 6 to 8 minutes on each side, until juices run clear, basting occasionally with the reserved marinade. Remove serve with your favorite vegetables. It's a winner!!

Travel season is coming if you need tires FMCA offers a National Fleet Pricing Program

Step 1: Get the specifications for the tires you need to have replaced. At this point, the program covers only motorhome tires. Step 2. Use the specifications to find out which Continental tire is a match. You can do this by calling Continental (704-583-8889) or the FMCA national office (800-543-3622), or by using the pricing tool at FMCA.com. This tool is extremely helpful and will give you pricing for every single tire that matches your search. Use the Tire Savings Calculator to get available tire pricing in the size you need. Step 3. Find a local Continental dealer who can do the install, and set up an appointment. In the Villages Wildwood Tire accepts this program.

Also let the dealer know which tire you are looking for. That way, you can be sure the dealer will have the tires in stock and ready for your appointment. You can find a list of dealers at www.continentaltruck.com/truck. From that page, select Dealer Locator in the top right corner.

Step 4. When you go to the dealer, show them your FMCA membership card.

You will pay the dealer directly for the tires and installation. Keep in mind that Continental quotes only the tire price and federal taxes.
