## Catalytic Converter Thefts

Often, we spend money on our RVs to make it look better or add suspension parts for a better ride, but one thing we never think about and can ruin a planned trip is the loss of your catalytic converter. And it's a national problem.

With Catalytic converter theft on the rise nationwide. Thieves can steal this antipollution device in a matter of minutes and sell it to scrap metal dealers for several hundred dollars for the precious metals it contains. What is heart breaking is going to the RV storage center to pick up your motorhome and find out your catalytic converter was stolen.

Class C and Class A gas RVs are often hit by thieves because it's easy to slide under the vehicle, it takes less than a minute to cut the connecting pipes using a battery-operated saw. In this day and age thieves are bold and have no respect for others.

What can you do to protect your catalytic converter? Investing in a cable locking device is an inexpensive way to protect the catalytic converter, they are easy to install, not overly expensive and less than replacing a catalytic converter. The internet is filled with such devices to protect the catalytic converter, which is part of the exhaust system that runs along the bottom of your vehicle. A few of the popular devices:

- A steel shield that fits over the catalytic converter, requiring time and extra tools to remove.
- Cages made of rebar or other high-strength steel that's difficult to cut.
- Stainless steel cables welded from the catalytic converter to the car's frame
- NAPA CatClamp Catalytic Converter Lock (see below)
