#### Where's Wheezy



Are you ready to get out of that chair and just go? Who isn't?? You need to look no farther that your own backyard, Florida that is. This time of year Florida is teeming with events, shows, and fairs. Pack up that RV, call some friends and go "On the Fly" or plan a small rally!

Here are just a few in the near future you might have never heard of, or have been anxious to try. Remember with the Covid situation, some might have restrictions or have been cancelled, check out the websites for more information.

#### Florida State Fair, Tampa, Feb. 10-21, 2022

It boasts "the largest midway in the USA," but its core purpose, celebrated for more than 100 years, is to showcase Florida's agriculture and its history.

#### **Everglades Seafood Festival, Everglades City. Feb. 11-13, 2022**

This free event in Florida's Stone Crab Capitol packs 'em in for fresh seafood, country music, carnival rides, crafts booths. An estimated 50,000 people attend each year in this small town (population 500) for the three-day event.

#### South Florida Garlic Fest, Wellington, Feb. 12-13, 2022

A big event with food and top musical performers, it started as a fundraiser for several non-profits. The festival outgrew Delray Beach and moved to Wellington Green.

#### 9th Annual Scottish Highland Festival, Mount Dora, Feb. 19-20, 2022

This gated event with a \$10 admission ticket features Scottish bands and musicians all the weekend at Donnelly Park. and an afternoon of Highland Games in Gilbert Park on Saturday from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m.

The Battle of Olustee Civil War Re-Enactment, Sanderson, Feb. 18-20, 2022 Florida's largest Civil War battle is re-enacted, with gun smoke, booming cannons and cavalry.

#### Cortez Commercial Fishing Festival, Cortez, Feb. 19-20, 2022

Cortez started as a fishing village, and it still has a working waterfront and fishing boats. The festival offers music, nautical arts and crafts, children's activities, environmental exhibits and lots of fresh seafood.

#### Coconut Grove Arts Festival, Coconut Grove, Miami, Feb. 19-20, 2022

A huge fair (covering many blocks with 350+ exhibitors) and a beautiful waterfront setting make this one of the most popular art festivals in Florida. As a result, it attracts top entertainers, food vendors and artists. Held annually on Presidents Day Weekend.



#### ArtiGras Fine Arts Festival, Jupiter, Feb. 19-20, 2022

A top juried festival with 300 artists, Artigras is celebrating 37 years of family fun this year.

#### Naples National Art Festival, Naples, Feb. 19-20, 2022

Ranked among the top art festivals in the state, the event takes place in scenic Cambier Park and along 8th Street South in downtown Naples.

#### Swamp Cabbage Festival, La Belle. Feb. 26-27, 2022

For 50+ years, this authentic Florida town east of Fort Myers has been celebrating swamp cabbage in a down-home festival and parade. A unique highlight: Armadillo races.

#### Florida Strawberry Festival, Plant City, March 3-13, 2022

Like a state fair, the Strawberry Festival has agricultural displays, livestock shows, arts and crafts, local food and a huge carnival midway. But its entertainment line-up is what's extraordinary year after year.

#### **Grant Seafood Festival, Grant-Sebastian, March 5-6, 2022**

The Grant Seafood Festival is put on by volunteers and has been held every year since 1966 in this sprawling riverside community between Melbourne and Sebastian.

#### Fort Myers Beach Shrimp Festival, Fort Myers Beach, March 12-13, 2022

There are still working fishing boats in this town pulling in shrimp from the Gulf and that's the reason Fort Myers Beach has held its shrimp festival for 50 years

Bike Week, Daytona Beach, March 4-13, 2022

#### Marathon Seafood Festival, Marathon, March 12-13, 2022

The Key's most popular seafood fest is the "original" in Marathon.
