Our First Member's Adventure

2021 RV Trip to Gillette, Wyoming

The purpose of this trip was 2-fold: attend the FMCA National Convention in Gillette, Wyoming which was being held at Cam-Plex Multi-Event Facility on July 7-10, 2021 and the second reason was to utilize Harvest Host as much as possible along the way.

Of course, it goes without saying that on a trip of this magnitude we took every opportunity to connect with family and old friends.

We belong to 2 other FMCA Chapters and were very glad to have met up with the Wisconsin Badgers group to travel with them from Wisconsin to Wyoming.

We had attended a few National Conventions before but they were always in Perry, Georgia. We had a fairly good idea what to expect at the Wyoming Rally and this rally did not disappoint. Well, actually having only 1 new RV on display was a disappointment to some but that being said, the rest of the convention was great. The purpose of this convention was to elect new national board members so meetings were always a part of most days for Bernie. We stayed for 6 days and while Bernie was attending meetings, Pat was free to roam. Mornings started off with free donuts and coffee followed by wondering over to where the venders had their displays. Pat purchased a much needed and wanted kitchen gadget that she just couldn't live without and picked up brochures on RV campgrounds and RV related topics. Classes were held and Pat attended one on genealogy, RV apps (will include a list of their favorites, below), and even one on comparing RV insurances. These classes were held daily and sign up is not usually needed. The glass fusion class and the ladies' luncheon are two examples when you need to sign up beforehand. A book signing by a local author was interesting. During our week we ventured into town to frequent the local establishments. Met interesting people all along the way and made some new friends. The second part of our 2-fold purpose for this trip was to experiment using Harvest Host. This type of camping we hadn't had much experience with so we thought we'd try it and see if we liked it. It is billed as being 'free camping' sooooo who doesn't like free?

All in all, we stayed at about 7 Harvest Host locations including: a Peach Orchard in Georgia; an Amish Museum in Indiana; the RV/MH Museum in Elkhart, Indiana; a brewery in Colorado; a camp ground in Colorado; and a winery in New Mexico. We also stayed at the FMCA Office (campground) in Cincinnati, Ohio. After having experienced a small sample of what Harvest Host had to offer, we have come up with a few conclusions: staying at a harvest host is a lovely and different way to see new areas you may not have initially included in your planned trip, they may be free to stay overnight but I can attest to the fact that it wasn't a 'cheap' stay, and not all stays are equal. With one exception, our experience with using Harvest Host was wonderful. The one exception was not Harvest Host's fault by any means. We came away from that experience with a new love of Peach ice cream, a new understanding of the evolution of the Amish way of life, realizing we found an area we could live if we ever decided to move, and how to spell charcuterie.



Travel with peace of mind, knowing you are covered if the unexpected happens

What do you need to do to enroll in this program? Absolutely nothing! As long as you are an active FMCA member, you are covered.

FMCAssist is emergency medical evacuation and repatriation coverage available to members worldwide as long as you are more than 75 miles from home. If you are a full-time RVer, you are always considered 75 miles from home. FMCAssist services are also available to members when traveling abroad. Some exclusions and limitation amounts pertain to these benefits.

UNDERSTAND THIS GREAT BENEFITS!

It is crucial that you understand what is included (and excluded) with your FMCAssist coverage. Coverage is the same whether you're a U.S. resident or Canadian resident, but some of the terminology is different.
